

# **Accessing the Bay Path Digital Archives**


### The Portico Digital Archives

The Bay Path Archives, housed in the Hatch Learning Commons on the main campus in Longmeadow, documents and preserves the history of the University, from its foundation in 1897 to the present day. The Archives includes selected Bay Path University publications, faculty and student publications, institutional and academic documents, University committee records, Board of Trustees records, administrative records, photographs, publicity, and student life records. It contains material that is of interest to students, faculty, staff, researchers, and alumni, such as yearbooks, photographs, and other information about life at Bay Path throughout its history. With funding provided through a federal IMLS grant to the Boston Public Library, the Hatch Learning Commons began to digitize selected content from the Bay Path Archives in 2013.


The University's collection of yearbooks, which were published as <u>The</u> <u>Portico</u>between 1921 and 2002, is available to view online. Some early years are missing.












### **Bay Path University Photograph Collection**

This collection contains photographs and slides amassed at the archives at Bay Path University from c. 1923-2006, with the majority of photographs from 1943 on. The photographs are of student life, professional conferences, the Bay Path campus and buildings, commencement ceremonies, homecomings and reunions, faculty and staff, academic life, sports, Bay Path celebrations, and a visit by

Margaret Thatcher.

The collection is arranged in 10 series, two of which have been further arranged into subseries. The series or subseries are arranged by event or subject and then ordered chronologically within each subject or event where allowed.


