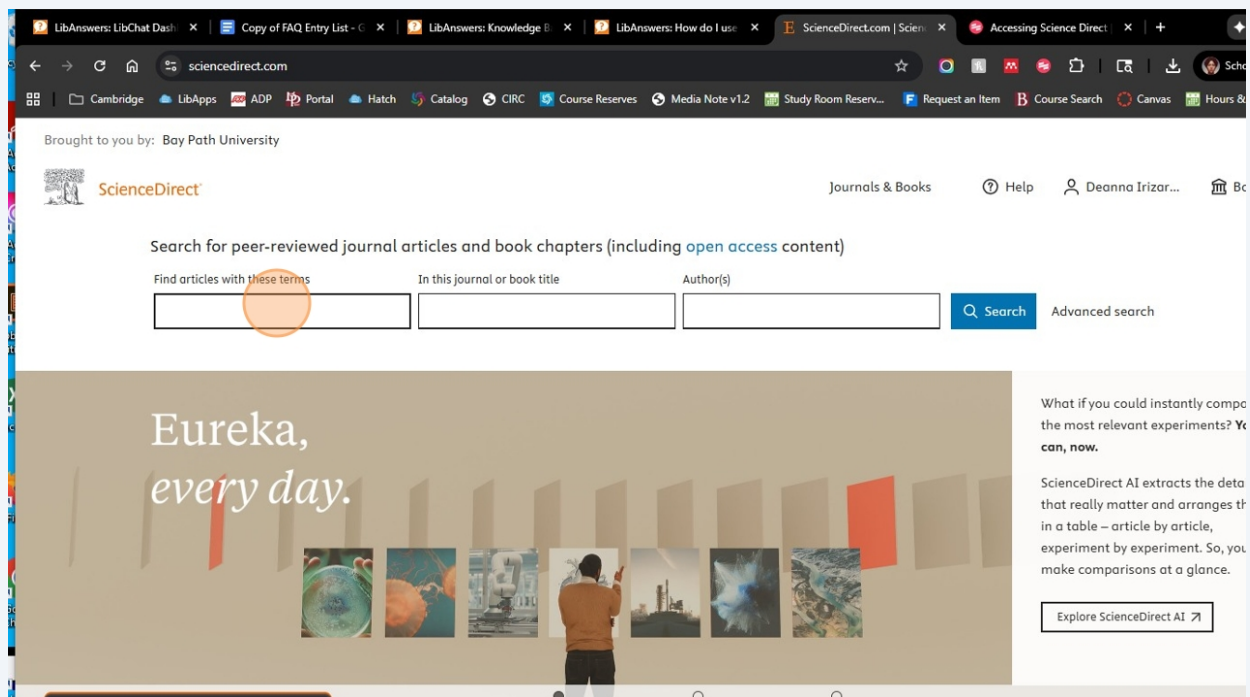


Accessing Articles on Science Direct on Campus

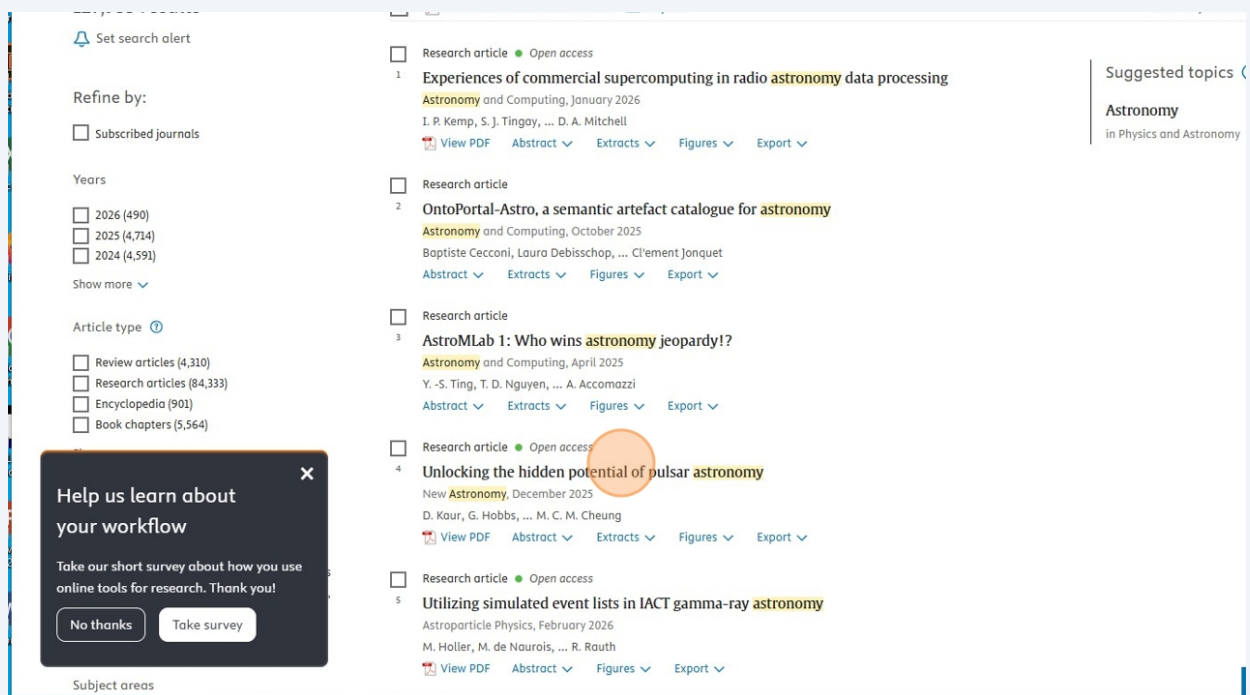


You can request up to three articles per day by following the process below. Any requests that you make beyond that will be requested through interlibrary loan. If the resource is not available through our subscriptions, the system will again ask you to request the resource through interlibrary loan.

11 Enter in your search terms.



12 Click an article.



13 Click **Order PDF** if the resource is not available through Bay Path.
